Pharmacy education and profession in India is regulated by the Pharmacy Council of India (PCI). It is a statutary body formed under the provisions of Pharmacy. Act 1948.

Responsibilities of PCI

1. The Pharmacy council of India regulates the practice of pharmacy in India

2.PCI prescribes standards required for pharmacist to practice in India.

3.It frames educational regulations for institutions providing pharmacy education.

4.1t approves the course of study and examination for pharmacists.

5.PCI maintains a central register of pharmacists.

6.It ensures uniform standard of pharmacy education in the country. $_{//}$





About D.Pharm

What is Pharmacy?

Students often have questions about what "pharmacy" really is. Before applying to a pharmacy programme, it is a good idea you have an understanding about what you are about to undertake. The following section is meant to provide an overview of the profession and provide answers to some of the common questions about studying and practicing pharmacy in India.

So what is pharmacy?

Pharmacy is a profession and field of the health sciences that is charged with the provision of ensuring safe and effective use of medications by the public. Traditionally pharmacy and the role of the pharmacist have included the compounding and dispensing of medications, however, more recently pharmacists are playing an increasing role in providing patient care and services including medication review, clinical practice, and drug information. They are responsible for communicating this knowledge to their patients, as well as other health care professionals as a member of an interdisciplinary team. Pharmacists are able to assess and determine if the drug therapy will be necessary, safe, and effective in an individual patient, while working as a part of a health care team to ensure this is realized.

Hence, pharmacy is much more than a field of study. It is a career which allows you to use your extensive knowledge of medications in order to improve the patient's drug therapy outcomes and enhance their quality of life. Rewarding, isn't it?



D.Pharm @ AMCP

Diploma in Pharmacy, popularly known as D. Pharm, is a two-year undergraduate diploma course offered by pharmacy colleges in India. The course is the minimum qualification to become a registered pharmacist in the country. Candidates having passed 10+2 exam or equivalent examination with Physics, Chemistry, Maths or Biology can eligible to pursue D. Pharm.

D.Pharm doesn't provide specialization to choose from; only the basic concepts of pharmaceutical science are taught in this course. After successfully completing two years of D. Pharm and after registering with Pharmacy Council of India (PCI) or the state Pharmacy Council, one can set up his/her own pharmacy/chemist, in order to stock and sell medicines and dispense them according to a registered medical practitioner's prescription. The main job opportunities for D.Pharm holders are to become a Pharmacist in Government sector, both state and central, private hospitals, medical stores, drug department in India and abroad. One can also become medical representative after pursuing the course.

As on today there are 32 D.Pharm colleges in Kerala in both government and private sector. Ayisha Majeed College of Pharmacy is one of the few Pharmacy Colleges in Kerala having 30 years of working experience.

Eligibility for Admission

Any candidate with a pass in any of the following examinations with physics, Chemistry and Biology or Mathematics,

I. Intermediate Examination in Science

II. The first year of the three-year degree course in Science.

III. 10+2/Equivalent examination (academic stream) in Science.

IV. Any other Qualification approved by the Pharmacy Council of India as equivalent to any of the above examinations.

For minority quota only Muslims are eligible. In the event of vacancy in Government seats and minority seats the same will be filled by the management, after the respective cut off dates by candidates irrespective of their religion or residential status.



Duration of the Course

The duration of the course shall be for two academic years, with each academic year spread over a period of not less than one hundred and eighty working days in addition to 500 hours practical training spread over a period of not less than three months.

Examinations

There shall be two examinations, Diploma in Pharmacy (part -I) to examine students at the end of the first year course and Diploma in Pharmacy (part -II) to examine the students at the end of the second year. Each examination will be held twice every year. The examinations will be held for both theory and practical and will carry 80 marks. The examination will be conducted by the Board of D.Pharm Examination, Govt. of Kerala, Trivandrum. In addition to the examination conducted by the Board of D.Pharm Examination, their shall be three sectional examinations were conducted by the college authorities before the final examination for both theory and practical. It is mandatory for the students to get the minimum stipulated marks in sectional examinations on an average.

Certification of Diploma in Pharmacy

The certificate of diploma in pharmacy shall be conferred by the examining authority to successful candidates on production of certificates of having passed the Diploma in Pharmacy (Part -II) Examination and completion of practical training.

Placement Cell

The Students Placement Cell contains all the information about the students. The system stores all the personal information of the students, like their personal details, their aggregate marks, their skill set and their technical skills that are required in the CV to be sent to a company.

We have helped a good number of Student Pharmacist to get placement in India and aboard has Pharmacist.

Award and Achievements

We are proud to state that we are having the best results in the final examinations with 1st Rank and 1st Classes and a very good pass percentage of during all most all the years.



Mode of Application

Application for admission should be made in the prescribed form. Application form can be obtained from the Principal, A.M. College of Pharmacy, Vavvakkavu, Karunagappally-690 528 on payment of Rs. 300/- in person or Rs. 350/- by M.O.

Selection of Candidate

The selection of candidates will be on merit basis and will be made by the selection committee constituted by the authorities. The decision of the committee in this regard shall be final.

Eligible candidates will be summoned for an Interview. The date of interview will be informed to the candidate.

Hostel Facility

Limited hostel facilities are available for girls only. Accommodation in the hostel will be allotted on first come first served basis.



General Regulations of the College

I. Strict discipline is expected from the students. Action will be taken against defaulters in the first instance itself.

II. Students should occupy their respective seats and at least 5 minutes early in the case of theory and practical classes.

III. Students shall not abstain themselves without leave. The name of students abstaining themselves for more than 10 working days will be removed from the rolls without any prior notice. They may be re-admitted at the discretion of the Principal in which case they will have to pay the admission fee once again.

IV. All serious cases of illness must be reported duly supported by medical certificate.

V. No student will be admitted to the class room unless he/she is well equipped with required instruments and necessities as and when inspection carried out by the concerned authorities.

VI. Students should develop a sense of belonging to the college. They should take pride in the fact that the properties of the college are their joint or common possession. They should see that no damage is caused to the college furniture and fixtures. Any student found causing damages to the college property will be liable to pay heavy fine extending up to Rs. 10,000/-

VII. Students are advised to refrain themselves from causing disturbance or nuisance within the college premises.

VIII.Students are forbidden from taking any active part in political or other agitation or party politics within the college premises. Any student found to violate any of the rules and regulations of the college or found disturbing the peace in campus will be prosecuted by the head of the institution, reserving the right to suspend or dismiss the students without an explanation. IX. Students whose presence, in the opinion of the college authorities may threaten the normal function of the college are also liable for suspension/dismissal. Students who are dismissed from the institution on disciplinary grounds will not be issued conduct certificates. The fees and other charges remitted to the college will not be refunded to such students.

Dress Regulations

Boys and Girls should wear uniform prescribed by the college. Girls should have their hair put up and should not wear flowers and excessive ornaments. White knee long apron is compulsory in practical class.

Fee Rules

The first year fee is payable at the time of admission and the second year fee is payable before the commencement of the second year classes. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. The fee structure is as fixed and notified by the Director of Medical Education from time to time, with respect to free seats and payment seats.

The candidate shall also furnish cash security or bond at the time of admission, for the proof of prompt payment of second year tuition fee, as the college is one of the self financing institution.
